Citations and References: Documenting your Sources

For two authors in an APA citation of journal, first give the information for the first author followed by a comma, then use an ampersand (&) and list the information for the second author. For three to seven authors, separate the author names with commas and again use an ampersand before the final author name.

A reference list is a complete list of references used in a piece of writing including the author name, date of publication, title and more. An APA reference list must: Be on a new page at the end of the document. Be centred. Be alphabetically by name of first author (or title if the author isn't known, in this case a, an and the should be ignored)

How to Cite Sources in APA Citation Format - Mendeley

An example of in-text citation would be (Johnson 2017) in parentheses, or it could be just a numeral in brackets or superscript. A reference list would then list all the citations in alphabetical or numeric order, depending on the author guidelines. Note that some style guides prefer to use the word "bibliography" instead of "references."

You can use information from your research in three ways: Paraphrase – Take the information from a specific paragraph or section of the article and rewrite it in your own words. Summarize – Write a broad overview of the section or the article in your own words. Quote – Repeat the exact words used by the author using quotation marks.

How to cite a journal in MLA | in-text & full citation ...

Here you find examples of how to write the reference list according to Harvard (a parenthetical referencing style also called the author-year or author-title style). When creating the reference list, sources should always be arranged in alphabetical order, sorted by the first author's last name or equivalent. Books with one author

To begin writing in your journal, label your first entry with the date, time and, optionally, location.
